Male and female facilities at either end of the Pavilion, each containing accessible toilet cubicles and sharps disposal, the female facilities contain a change table 2. Inside The International Cricket Hall of Fame are male, female and parenting facilities, as well as accessible facilities with emergency release door. - There are five emergency exits and one primary point of entry/exit on the Ground Floor of The International Cricket Hall of Fame. - Bradman Foundation Staff working with children have undertaken a Working with Children Check - Volunteer guides working with children have signed Working with Children declaration.
